Description:

For safety reasons, any student found on the roof of the school or climbing in the ceilings without permission will be suspended from school.

Honesty: "Honesty is not only the best policy but should be a way of life." C.E. Kingston

Any student who takes anything out of another student's desk or a teacher's desk without permission or any theft of property will have immediate action taken.

1st offense: K4- 2nd grade: . Conference with the teacher on the moral reason why we should be honest. Contact parents.

3rd – 6th .Student is on red and behavior policy will be followed. Student will meet with administration and will be taken through the steps of repentance. Parent will be contacted.

2nd offense: K4-2nd grade: Conference with teacher and remind student of the moral reason why we should be honest. Contact parent. 3rd – 6th .Student is on red and behavior policy will be followed. Student will meet with administration and will be taken through the steps of repentance. Parent will be contacted.

3rd and all other offenses: Student is on red.

Copying someone else's assignment or test, letting someone copy your assignment or test, or accessing the answer keys without the teacher's supervision or permission is cheating. If a student cheats, the following will result:

1st offense:

K4 – 3rd grade: The student will redo their test or assignment. Student will conference with the teacher on the moral reason for honesty. Both parents will be called by their teacher. Document behavior in Jupiter grades.

4th – 6th grade: Student will receive a 0 on the assignment or test that was cheated on. Students will conference with the teacher on the moral reason for honesty. The student will pull to a level 2 (orange) and go through steps of repentance. Both parents will be called by their teacher. The student will have a chance to retake the test or assignment after all steps are completed. Document behavior in Jupiter grades.

2nd offense:

K4– 3rd grade: The student will redo their test or assignment. Student will conference with the teacher on the moral reason for honesty. Both parents will be called by their teacher. Document behavior in Jupiter grades.

4th – 6th grade: Student will receive a 0 on the assignment or test that was cheated on. Students will conference with the teacher on the moral reason for honesty. The student will pull to a level 2 (orange) and go through steps of repentance. Both parents will meet with the administration to create an action plan to correct the problem. The student will have a chance to retake the test or assignment after all steps are completed. Document behavior in Jupiter grades.

High morals: Let no corrupting talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for building up, as if it is in the occasion, that it may give grace to those who hear. Ephesians 4:29

Any student who swears or uses profane or foul language will be pulled to level two (orange) and both parents will be notified. If it happens a second time, they will be pulled to level 1 (red) and Citizenship and Behavior Management policy will be followed.

Chastity and Virtue: For I the Lord God delighteth in the chastity of Man Jacob 2:28

Any student using indecent exposure will have both parents notified. K4-2nd grade will be referred to administration and pulled to red. 3rd to 6th will be suspended.

No student will touch any other student in private and inappropriate places. Any such incident should be referred to administration immediately. Disciplinary action for second grade will be decided on a case by case basis. 3rd through 6th will be referred to administration and then suspended. Parents will be contacted. Any exception will be evaluated on a case by case basis.

There will be no boyfriend/girlfriend relationships or Public Displays of Affection (PDA) between boy and girl. 1st offense: Each individual situation should be referred to administration, will be evaluated, and a decision will be made as to how it should be handled. Administration will contact and involve parents. Severe cases may result in suspension or expulsion.

Immoral inappropriate Pictures Literature drawings

Any student bringing immoral, inappropriate pictures literature or drawings to school and showing other students:
2nd to 3rd grade will be handled on a case by case basis that will include a meeting with the child's parents.
4th to 6th grade will be pulled to red and a meeting set up with parents to correct the issue. Citizenship and Behavior Management Policy will be followed.

Sexual Harassment

Any sexual harassment cases or suspected cases will be referred to administration immediately. This can include inappropriate name calling and talking/teasing about immoral and inappropriate things in a sexual manner. Students who say or write (notes) sexually inappropriate things will have both parents notified by administration. 2nd Grade will pull to orange. 3rd to 6th grade will pull to red. Citizenship and Behavior Management policy will be followed.

Respect

Students will be kind and respectful to each other, any physical fighting will be handled at the discretion of the teacher through the Citizenship and Behavior policy.

A student who hits or kicks or physically hurts their teacher will be pulled to red and parents called. Suspension or expulsion may apply. Citizenship and Behavior policy will be followed.

A student who yells at or speaks disrespectfully to their teacher may be pulled to orange and parents will be called.
