### **General Precautions**

- •Be your child's best example. Please be courteous and always follow safety guidelines.
- •No arrivals prior to listed times. No supervision provided.
- Eollow all directions from school safety personnel. They may see potential problems you cannot.
- •Devote more time and be extra cautious on snowy, rainy, or foggy days. Drive with your headlights on, to see and to be seen.
- •Please drive slowly and watch for children.
- •Do not use your cell phone while driving on the drop-off and pick-up lane.
- Pull as far forward as possible before dropping-off and loading your children.
- Children should exit and enter on the passenger's side only.
- Drop-off and pick-ups are in the loading/unloading zone area and directed by MSPA staff.
- •Do not pass other vehicles to pull in front of them to pick up your child.
- nce your child is in the vehicle, you may pull carefully out.
- It will take a few extra minutes of your time to utilize the drop-off and pick-up safety lane zone when school begins and lets out but please recognize that our staff are working quickly to unload and load students safely into cars and to keep traffic moving.

#### **Late Arrivals**
